 one Thousand Dollars for the payment
 of which we and truly to be made
 and done we bind ourselves our
 heirs executors administrators and
 assigns firmly by this ⁴prose sealed
 with our seals and dated this the 15th day
 of August 1877 the condition of the
 above obligation is such that whereas
 the above Bond William L Black
 was on the 6th day of August 1877
 elected Justice of the Peace in
 Beat No. 10. in and said county
 now if the said William L Black shall
 faithfully discharge the duties of such
 office during the time he continues
 therein on discharge any of the
 duties thereof then the above obligation
 to be void otherwise to remain of
 full force and effect
